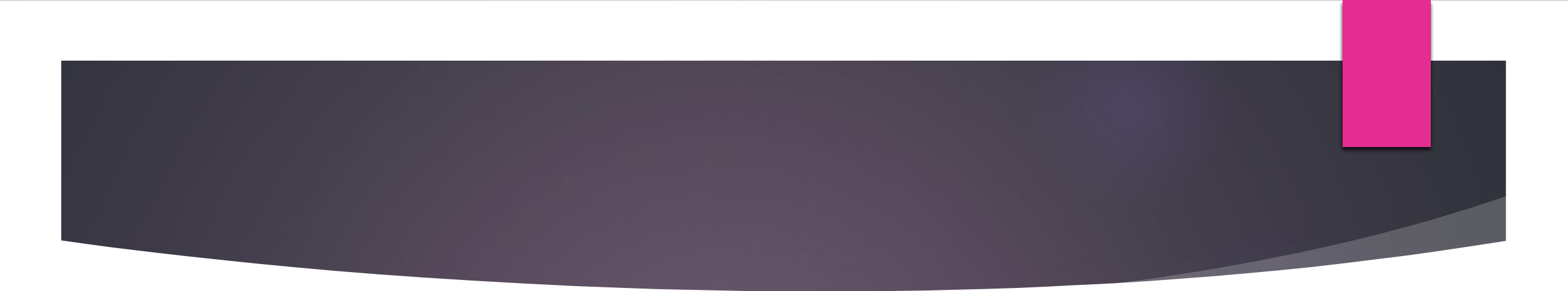
Good behaviour

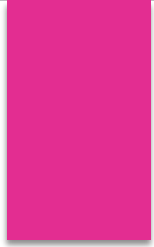
