Expectations:

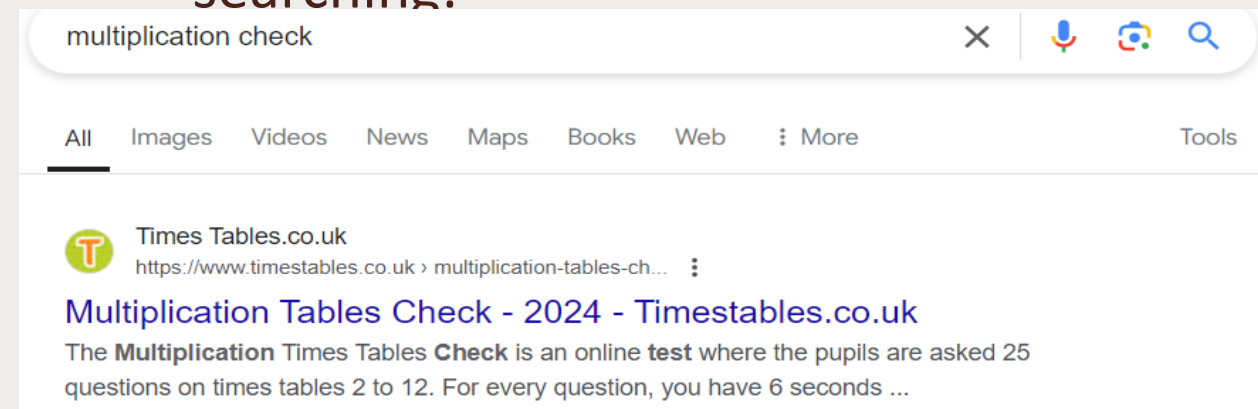
- Reading – everyday.

Expectations:

- At the end of year 4, during the month of June, children will take a multiplication check.
- They will need to learn all of their times table (2-12).
- Children will complete 25 questions, 6 seconds per question on the tablet.

Homework

Children will be allocated a **reading book**, please encourage your children to read daily. You must record comments at least once a week on go read.

Each week on a Friday children will be given **spellings** and they will have a spelling test the following Friday. Children will be expected to practice these spellings 3 times a week, not all in one day. These spellings will be taken from year 4 common exception words and statutory spelling rules.

Projects will be set each half term and submitted before the holidays. This will be based around learning in school.

Homework will be set on **google classroom**. This could be reading extracts before a lesson, a Maths video to help re-cap learning in school or extra interventions for some children.
